

HOW BESE DISTRICT 2 IS DOING ON EARLY CARE AND EDUCATION



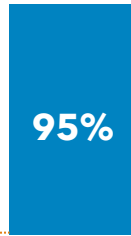
While early care and education **program quality** has improved, **birth to 3 access** to these programs **remains an issue in BESE District 2.**
