
A SNAPSHOT OF EARLY CARE & EDUCATION IN BESE DISTRICT 1





The vast majority of child care programs in BESE District 1 are meeting state quality benchmarks, providing a smart start for children and a smart investment for families. While early care and education program quality has improved, access to quality birth to 3 programs remains an issue. However, most in-need 4-year-olds in BESE District 1 have access to a child care program.
