
A SNAPSHOT OF EARLY CARE & EDUCATION IN BESE DISTRICT 3

In BESE District 3, only 16% of in-need children birth to age 3 are served by public programs, while 87% of 4-year-olds are.

The vast majority of child care programs in BESE District 3 are meeting state quality benchmarks, providing a smart start for children and a smart investment for families. While early care and education program quality has improved, access to quality birth to 3 programs remains an issue. However, most in-need 4-year-olds in BESE District 3 have access to a child care program.
